PUBLIC INVITATION TO SUBMIT A BID

in an open procedure for the public procurement of navigational software for flight planning and an electronic database of airport maps
(JH 88/D/10)

The subject of this public procurement procedure is the purchase of navigational software for flight planning and an electronic database of airport maps, defined in more detail in the Tender Documentation Package – the Specification.

All interested parties that fulfill the mandatory requirements outlined in Article 44. of the Public Procurement Law and submit evidence as outlined in Article 45. of the Law, have the right to participate in this procedure. With a bid and evidence listed in Article 45. of the Public Procurement Law and described in detail within the Tender Documentation Package, the Bidder must also submit other documents and forms contained in the Tender Documentation Package. The Bidder shall submit evidence that it is an authorized distributor / dealer for offered software products, at the time of bid submission.

The criterion for the selection of the most advantageous bid is the lowest price offered.

Direct insight into the Tender Documentation Package, as the well as the receipt of Tender Documentation Package copies can be conducted any business day following the date of publication of the Public Invitation in the "The Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", between 12,00 and 14,00 hours, at the Procuring Entity's address. The Bidder's representative must submit an authorization to receive the Tender Documentation Package, with the following indication: "For the receipt of the Tender Documentation Package, as per Public Invitation no. 88/D/10". The authorization to receive the Tender Documentation Package must also bear contact details.

At the Bidder's request, the Tender Documentation Package can be submitted to the Bidder via post or electronic mail. The Procuring Entity shall not bear responsibility in the case that the documents should disappear or arrive late.

The Bid shall be prepared and submitted in accordance with this Public Invitation and the Tender Documentation Package. Alternative bids are not acceptable. The validity period of the Bid cannot be less than 60 days from the date the bids are opened.

Bids, along with the relevant documentation shall be submitted directly or via post, at the address of the Serbia and Montenegro Air Traffic Services Agency, Ltd., at Trg Nikole Pašića 10, 11000 Belgrade, in sealed envelopes bearing a visible note: "Bid for the Public Procurement of Navigational Software for Flight Planning and an Electronic Database of Airport Maps – JN 88/D/10 – DO NOT OPEN". At the reverse

side of the envelope, the name, address and telephone number of the Bidder must be indicated.

The deadline for bid submission is 30 days from the date of publication in "The Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia". All bids that arrive by 11,00 hours on the last day of the named deadline, at the Procuring Entity's address indicated in this Public Invitation, regardless of the method of delivery, will be perceived as timely. If the deadline expires on a day that is not a business day, the last day of the named deadline shall be deemed to be the first business day that follows, by 11,00 hours.

Untimely, unclosed bids, bids with incomplete documentation, as well as bids that are not in harmony with this Public Invitation and the Tender Documentation Package, shall not be reviewed.

Public opening of the bids shall be conducted on the day of expiry of the deadline for bid submission, at 11,15 hours, at the Public Entity's address indicated in this Invitation. Bidder representatives that will participate in the public bid opening procedure shall, at the beginning of the public opening procedure, furnish authorizations for the participation in the procedure.

The Decision of the most advantageous bid shall be adopted within ten days from the date of public opening of bids.

All interested parties may submit written requests to the Procuring Entity, for additional information or explanations with respect to bid preparation, five days prior to the deadline for bid submission, at the latest.
